We appreciate & congratulate the combined efforts of our teachers, students & parents. We presented the 5th batch of class X students in April 2022. Let me give you the details of the results of the 2022 exams.

Blossoms has achieved immense success in the board exam 2022. All the Blossomites have been passed in 1st division & the School topper was Sailatirtha Sivapriya, who has scored 96%. Almost in every subject we have our Blossomites secured more than 95% & in SSC, Swaroop Ranjan Samal has achieved 100%.

PTM ACTIVITIES

Regular PTMs were conducted throughout the year, it offered a great platform to both parents and teachers to share insights and information for the development of the children.

ACADEMICS

Academics is the core focus of at Blossoms. All the possible efforts have been taken and, we will continue to take, to ensure academic excellence in our school. We believe that excellence in academics is the hall mark of our school, as a good institution.

ONLINE & OFFLINE CLASSES

The academic year 2021-2022 commenced with the exclusive online classes initially and later, a hybrid model of online as well as face to face classes were introduced. Detailed guidelines were issued by the health authority to be followed during the pandemic.

In this academic session, the school has primarily been working in an online/hybrid mode in accordance with the government regulations. All classes and students were in touch with their class teachers and subject teachers through many virtual modes. Efforts were being made to

ensure that all students actively participated in the online mode and ensured that maximum learning outcomes. Teachers conducted their online lectures with attractive and informative Power point presentations, online activities and even conducted the Periodic tests and Examinations through the online medium.

When the school reopened physically for a brief period, all precautions of sanitization, thermal checking, wearing of mask and social distancing was maintained. Care was also taken to ensure that the staff were vaccinated well in advance to provide a safe and secure school environment. Once the students got back into the daily routine of regular classes, most of the students of class IX and X were vaccinated with both doses.

THE SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Curriculum was modified for online classes. Rigorous curriculum modification took place for KG section. The curriculum was modified, revised and enriched to enhance the quality. Later, when the face to face classes started, emphasis were given to the theme based teaching with lots of importance on speaking skills along with other skills. Also, enough focus was given on fun activities such as art, dance and music classes along with physical education.

For Grade 1 to Grade 8, curriculum was developed in such a way that it ensured of meeting the needs of our students, it was rigorously revised and enriched to make students more competent to face future exams. For standard 9 & 10, CBSE had modified the curriculum keeping the pandemic in mind.

ART INTEGRATION

CBSE introduced the concept of Art Integration in the National Education Policy. In a circular by CBSE to all affiliated schools were supposed to integrate art in such a manner to make learning joyful.

The liberty to choose any kind of art form whether visual or performing art opened varied fields for students to explore.

ASSESSMENT SYSTEM

Blossoms has established a robust assessment system across all the grades. Our assessment helps in enhancing student's achievement and progress.

SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Subject enrichment activities aimed at the understanding and skill development of children. These activities permitted students to apply knowledge to the next level. It sustained the enthusiasm of students to put their best foot forward.

QUALITY ASSURANCE IN TEACHING

Excellence in education and fostering the love of learning is the hallmark of Blossoms School. Our staff of dedicated and sincere teachers are working to improve the academic standards of both the Pre Primary, Primary & Secondary sections. Efforts are made to promote the holistic development of students encouraging them to participate in both, curricular and co-curricular activities.

All the efforts have been taken to ensure quality in teaching. We have competent teachers during the current academic year and the selection process for the next academic year is going on. We have a very robust system of teacher's lesson observation which includes observation by the principal and Coordinator. A series of Professional Development sessions on various topics were organised for all the teachers.

STUDENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES

Just like every year, in the year 2021-22 too our students actively participated in all school activities & events but with a difference i.e in the virtual mode. These included Drawing and poster making event, Greeting card making event in the pre primary and primary sections.

Festivals and celebrations like Holi, Christmas, Rakshabandhan, Ganesh Festival etc. are also an integral part of the student's development. All national, religious and regional festivals are held throughout the year to educate the children about the rich cultural and religious heritage of India. These events sensitize the students towards living in harmony in a diverse society – and encourage them to pay respect to the customs and traditions of all religious communities. School Founders Day was also celebrated with various online activities.

All class assemblies were conducted in the online mode. Through these students gained confidence. Every class participated with full enthusiasm on the various topics given to them – baniathy on virtues.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The school library is a centre that provides a range of learning opportunities for students as well as teachers with a flair for reading and knowledge. In addition to classroom visits with collaborating teachers, the school library also serves as a learning space for students to do independent work on writings and project works. The library has a large variety of books, magazines, newspapers, ranging from fictions for primary students to classics of world literature. The books and journals have been arranged meticulously in different shelves.

SCIENCE LABORATORY

Effective teaching and learning in science involves a perpetual state of show and tell. Our school combines classroom teaching with laboratory experiments from beginning of secondary level itself so that students are able to grasp each and every concept thoroughly. It is also believed that laboratory teaching and experiments that are conducted there, will help encourage a deeper understanding in children. Children are able to

retain knowledge for much longer when they see the experiments being performed in front of them. Blossoms has a composite lab installed on the ground floor. These labs are renovated regularly for getting a first-hand learning experience by performing different experiments on their own. Another 3 lab are being constructed for senior secondary classes.

COMPUTER LABORATORY

Blossoms has a well-equipped computer laboratory containing 20 computers in the ground floor, this lab plays an important role in understanding the computer programming and making programs on their own. This practical learning help the students to increase their scientific and technological research and invention capacity. Students are allowed to devote their free time in learning computer programming to improve their computer skills.
